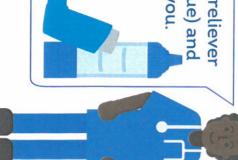

My asthma is getting worse It...

- I wheeze or cough, my chest hurts or it's hard to breathe, or
- I need my reliever inhaler (usually blue) three or more times a week, or
- My peak flow is less than . 9
- I'm waking up at night because of my asthma (this is an important sign and will book a next day appointment)

If my asthma gets worse, I will:

- Take my preventer medicines as normal
- And also take reliever inhaler every four hours puff/s of my blue
- See my doctor or nurse within 24 hours if I don't feel better
