

Next year I will be in year 4 in Robin Class

The other class is called Sparrow and they will be taught by Mr Evans. The other adults who will help me to do my learning in the class will be Mrs Symes and Mrs Blackwell.

My class next year will be a mixture of people from Wren class and Goldcrest class. This means that I will be with some people I know well as they were in my class in Year 3, and some people who will be new for me. This is good. I may want to stay with people I know at first. In Year 4 we will do lots of new learning. Some of this will be building on things that I already know, like how to add or take away or how to write a sentence with a noun and verb. You might feel excited or nervous about coming into Year 4. This is okay. Lots of children will feel exactly the same as you.
